- The facility for voting through Ballot Paper System shall also be made available at the Extra Ordinary General Meeting at 15, RB, Ugrasen Road, Dehradun, Uttarakhand 248 001 on 5th Day of August, 2023 between 5.30 PM to 9.00 PM and members of the Company as on cut-off date attending the meeting who have not already casted their vote by REMOTE E-VOTING SYSTEM shall be able to exercise their voting right at the meeting.

Centre notifies transfer of 3 HC judges

New Delhi: The law ministry on Thursday notified transfer of three high court judges from Kerala, Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.

The judges who have been shifted "in consultation" with the Chief Justice of India include Justice Donadi Ramesh, a judge of the Andhra Pradesh High Court, to the Allahabad HC; Justice Karmeganti Lalitha Kumari from Telangana HC to the Karnataka HC and Justice Vipul Manubhai Pancholi of the Gujarat HC to the Patna HC.

Justice Pancholi's transfer was recommended by the apex court collegium last September and had been pending with the government since then. The transfers of justices Ramesh and Lalitha were recommended by the collegium last year in November.

On Wednesday, the government had also notified appointment of two judges for the Supreme Court as recommended by the collegium. The new judges were chief justices of the High Court of Telangana, Justice Ujjal Bhuyan and Justice S Venkatanarayana Bhatti, CJ of Kerala HC. TNN

Consensual sex is not rape: HC

Ahmedabad: The Gujarat high court came to the rescue of a man for the second time, as he faced accusations of rape twice from the same woman in 2018. She had accused him of raping her for six years by making false promises of marriage.

The HC discharged him from the rape case that was lodged with Gujarat University police station in August 2018. Earlier, it had quashed a rape complaint filed with Mahidharpura police station in Surat in May 2018. While discharging the man from the case registered in Ahmedabad, Justice Gita Gopi said, "There is no ground to even assume that he has committed the offence to consider the culpability of the accused. The case is of consensual sex."

This case involved a married man and a married woman with two kids. As their relationship lasted for six years, the woman got divorced from her husband. When the relationship turned awry, the woman lodged an FIR in Surat. However, when the man moved the HC for quashing of the FIR, the woman consented to it and the HC junked the FIR registered with Mahidharpura police.

However, she filed another complaint in Ahmedabad. The man's quashing plea was not entertained by the HC and he unsuccessfully sought discharge from the city sessions court. He approached the HC for discharge in the second case with the argument that the woman was divorced, and she had abandoned her husband and children. It was a consensual sexual relation between them for six years. TNN
