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Agra temple row: Muslims show solidarity with Hindu protesters

Agra: Vishwa Hindu Parishad and Bajrang Dal activists recited 'Hanuman chalisa' at the office of the DRM in Agra to protest against the Indian Railways' decision to shift the 250-year-old Chamunda Devi temple from the platform of Raja Ki Mandi railway station in Agra, as part of their bid to remove illegal encroachments on railway lands.

Expressing their solidarity, people from the Muslim community, too, led by BJP leader Shabana Khandelwal, called this "a matter of faith" and said that the government should not do anything to hurt the sentiments of the community.

Khandelwal, also the national president of All India Ulema board (women wing), said, "I will be the first to stand before the bulldozer if the authorities use it for demolition of the temple." She added that "the construction of new religious structures can be stopped by the government or administration but removing an ancient temple is not acceptable."

In the notice issued on April 20 to the temple's priest, the railway authorities had alleged that the temple structure was causing inconvenience to passengers and affecting safety of train operations.
