- In accordance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (the Rules) including the amendments thereto, the Company is pleased to provide facility to its members, to cast their vote electronically for all the resolutions proposed at the 122nd Annual General Meeting of the Company.
- The Company has appointed National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) to provide e-voting facility to the members.
- Business shall be transacted through Remote Voting by Electronic Means (E-Voting) under the Bipartite Agreement with National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL).
- The remote e-voting period commences at 9:00 Hrs (IST) on 26th June 2023 (Monday) and closes at 17:00 Hrs (IST) on 28th June 2023 (Wednesday) NSDL will send User id and password at your registered email id and mobile number
- Remote e-voting shall not be allowed beyond the said date and time.
- Remote E-Voting User Login ID and Password with Instructions shall be received by the Members directly by an email /SMS from NSDL provided the Member has registered with updated email id and mobile number up to the notified cut-off date of Saturday, 10th June 2023.
- Once you receive email from NSDL, to obtain user id and password, open the attached PDF file viz.: "e-voting.pdf" with your Membership No. as Password.
Membership number should be alphanumeric only, it should not contain any special characters like (-, /, etc). for example, if membership number is P-3333 then use P3333 to open attached PDF file.
- You will also receive User and password through sms at your mobile number if mobile number is registered with Dehradun Club Ltd
- The facility for voting through ELECTRONIC VOTING SYSTEM shall also be made available at the meeting at 15, RB, Ugrasen Road, Dehradun, Uttarakhand 248 001 on Thursday, 29th day of June 2023 between 6.00 PM and 9.00 PM and members of the Company, as of cut off date, attending the meeting who have not already cast their vote by REMOTE E-VOTING SYSTEM shall be able to exercise their voting right at the meeting. The process of electronic voting system will be same as the process of voting through remote e-voting system.
- The Members who have cast their vote by remote e-voting prior to the meeting may also attend the meeting but shall not be entitled to cast their vote again.
- A person whose name is recorded in the register of members or in the register of beneficial owners maintained by the depositories (if any) as on the cut-off date only shall be entitled to avail the facility of remote e-voting as well as voting in the general meeting.

Dehradun: Around 40 years ago, two villages in Chamba block of Tehri Garhwal district, Jardhari and Chopdiyal, decided to save forests which had turned barren due to forest fires and timber mafia. Preeti Jardhari and Seema Dabral, pradhans of Jardhar and Chopdiyal villages, will be felicitated with "Green and Clean award" on Monday on World Environment Day (June 5) by the Union ministry of environment, forest and climate change (MoEFCC).

Vijay Jardhari, founder of the "Save Seed Revolution" (an organisation that preserves seeds of diverse varieties in Tehri Garhwal) and a resident of Jardhar, said, "In the 1980s, our forest had almost lost all its trees due to forest fires, timber mafia and several other reasons. With the trees gone, six reservoirs of our village dried up. We decided to form a 'Van Suraksha Samiti' and planted trees like Oak, Baanj and Buransh (some of these retain water). Eventually, the forest became

lush and all the reservoirs were replenished."

Chopdiyal village has a similar story. "Here villagers planted cash crops after turning a 7-km stretch of forest green by afforestation drives. This changed the entire landscape and we have ample water and more fertile soil," said Vinod Dabral, husband of Seema Dabral, the pradhan of Chopdiyal village.

The village is known for cultivating cash crops like high-priced fruits and vegetables. The village also operates on solar energy. Jardhari added,

"Nature has its own way of handling its ecosystem. We simply ensured that no one is damaging the forest and that's how the entire system rejuvenated itself."

Two held for posing as
Bishnoi gang members

Dehradun: Haridwar district police on Sunday arrested two persons, a tea stall owner and a labourer, for allegedly pretending to be members of the Lawrence Bishnoi gang and making extortion calls to businessmen. The arrests were made in the course of investigation into the threat calls received by a local hardware trader.

Ajai Singh, senior superintendent of police, Haridwar, said, "A case was registered on June 2 and police formed a special team to nab the accused. During investigation, police tracked down the two accused, Virendra

aka Chota Sunar, a temporary tea stall owner from Raiwala, Dehradun and Govind Baba, a labourer from Khadkhadi Haridwar." Singh added, "The two were nabbed after we traced the contact number used to make the calls and send the SMSs. The phone was also seized. The two confessed during interrogation that they were doing it for easy money. After getting the contact number of the complainant from his shop board, the two made the extortion call. During the probe, turned out they had made similar calls to two traders, Raiwala, Dehradun, for which they had been booked by Dehradun police."
